THE 'WORK IT NOW' RULES

- * All-over matte can be tricky to pull off with summer complexions. Choose one area of your face to play up and go for it. 'Eyeshadow is the most wearable way to work this trend,' says Terry.
- * Go for next season's retro blue eye colours – try a bright blue if you're still tanned or opt for more of a baby blue if you're pale.
- * A block of colour is the way to wear this right now. Build up the intensity by applying a blue kohl pencil all over your eyelid first and then sweep your eyeshadow over the top. ■
